



Build an indoor winter den in the classroom

Why not make an indoor story telling den in the classroom and hibernate like bears?

You'll need:

- some space!
- blankets and sheets,
- chairs or a clothes airer?
- cushions and pillows
- soft toys
- string /pegs to attach your blankets to the frame



Make your den by arranging the chairs or clothes airer as your walls and then draping a sheet or blanket over the top for your roof, secure this with string or clothes pegs. Put cushions or pillows on the floor to make it cosy. You could add decorations like fairy lights or scarves or bunting.

You could bring soft toy animals from home (such as a bear or a fox) to help you tell the snow child story. Then snuggle up with something warm to drink (your snow child hot chocolates, for example!)

Think about the Snow Child story you have watched - Can you remember the story and what happened, who were the main characters and which one was your favourite?

What did you like or dislike about the story? How did the story make you feel? Do you think Snow Child stayed for the summer?

If you are working as a class group you could divide into groups and each make your own den then visit each other's dens to retell the story and make up your own versions of the story.
