Billy's tried the alarm clock with a loud bell sound which didn't work, an alarm with music, an alarm with a propeller, an alarm that sprays water.....It still ends up with his Mum shouting at him every morning which doesn't make for a good start. His brother Patrick suggested a wind chime because it has that kind of sound that weaves it's way into your dreams and leads you back out into the new day.

How to make WiLd! Wind Chimes:



You'll need to hunt around for some natural objects that will make a noise when they bang together – sticks or shells both work well. You'll also need a stick you can bend into a ring – willow is good but if not wire will work!



You'll also need a metal lid (without sharp edges) ask an adult to make a hole in this with a skewer or screw driver.



Make a ring of bendy sticks or thick wire and attach a stick across the centre (dividing it in half) Thread some wool or string through your lid and tie it in the centre of your cross bar



Then tie your sticks or shells from the ring around your lid so they hit the lid when the wind blows!



Hang outside your window or somewhere else it will catch the wind!
